You must have received the Weekly Schedule emails listing out the various curricular material we use in our Learning System.

Here's a quick guide to help you use them effectively :

1) **Worksheets :**

- The printed worksheets have already been handed over to you, for the two weeks of April. In case you cannot or have not collected them, the soft copies of these worksheets are available through the Weekly Schedule emails.
- You can download the files and either print them or just keep them open on the device you are using.
- You will be assigned regular homework based on the worksheets, which you will have to complete and upload as per the teacher's instructions. The teacher will then check it and give you feedback on your work.
- If you are regular in your worksheet / homework submissions, you will win Walnut talents! More about that in later emails.

2) **PowerPoint Presentations :**

- The PowerPoint presentations that you receive, have a lot of formatting and animation added to them. If you simply open them in the browser, they would look weird! The fonts would not be displayed properly, and you may also notice some images overlapping the text. Do not worry!
- These PowerPoint presentations are not meant to be viewed via the browser. Please download them to your computer (desktop, laptop, etc.) and only then view them. The font, formatting and animation would all be back in place, once you do so!
- You may notice that the file name of the presentation that you download might be the same across periods. That is not a problem. Sometimes, the same presentation can be used for multiple periods.
- **What should you do if you don't have a desktop or a laptop?**
In such a case, you will need to download the Microsoft PowerPoint app to your mobile phone. The presentations will then play via this app.

3) eLearning videos :

- Most of our PowerPoint presentations have also been converted into eLearning lectures, with a voiceover added for you to understand the correct pronunciation of the words.
- These have been uploaded on YouTube and so are not restricted to any device compatibility. You can view these if your device distorts the PowerPoint presentations.

4) Teacher's Audio instructions :

- The audio instructions created by our teachers ideally play directly in the browser.
- In case you face any difficulty in their playback, please download the audio files to your local device. Then, play these audios via the VLC Player.

5) NCERT textbooks :

- In case you do not have access to hard copies of textbooks, the soft copies are easily available on the NCERT website.
- You can access the textbooks online via : <http://ncert.nic.in/textbook/textbook.htm>
Select the correct Class -> Subject -> Book Title, as per your requirement. You will be able to access the entire textbook in the PDF format.
- You can also download the entire textbook or individual chapters by using the Download option on the top right corner, once the textbook is visible on the screen.
